

Behaviour in the event of a fire

In the event of a fire, it is important to intervene immediately to limit damage as far as possible. Keep calm and follow the three golden rules of conduct:

ALARM (PHONE 118), RESCUE, EXTINGUISH

1 Alarming



- Alarm the fire brigade: **Phone 118**
- Warn endangered persons
- Wait for queries and instructions from the fire brigade
- We Other emergency numbers: **ambulance 144, police 117**

2 Rescue



- Rescue people and animals from the burning room
- Close windows and doors and exit the fire via escape routes
- Leaving heavily smoky rooms by crawling
- Do not use lifts
- For smoky staircases: Stay in the flat and wait by the window for the fire brigade

3 Extinguish



- Observe your own safety
- Fight the fire with suitable means (hand fire extinguisher, fire blanket etc.)
- Fight fire from bottom to top
- Instruct the arriving fire brigade
