Summer news from the Lenk-Simmental holiday region

The region in the western Bernese Oberland presents a colourful bouquet of experiences for the summer. From rock 'n' roll to jazz, blues, classical, pop and rock to folk sounds and readings - the summer of 2023 in the Simmental will be marked by a wide variety of festivals and events. There is also news on the mountain or for families.

Festival «Simmenklänge» – 16 to 18 June 2023

Young musicians will make the mountain world of Lenk resound during the three-day festival. Master class in singing with opening concert, chamber music, opera brunch, house concerts and a children's project. In collaboration with the Bern University of the Arts. www.kulturlenk.ch

Adelboden-Lenk test operation mountain bike trial

With the opening of the bike trail at Höchst in Adelboden, the first official routes of the Bikeregion Adelboden-Lenk were also signalled. Hikers and bikers are «on the road together» on these sections. In a first step, the routes to Höchst and back as well as the Lenk single trail classic Summerwald on Betelberg were sign-posted. The aim of the three-year trial operation is to clarify as many questions as possible about coexistence, management and maintenance.

Five different altitude levels create habitats with their typical bird species: bearded and griffon vulture, golden and short-toed eagle, red kite, kestrel, whinchat and skylark.
